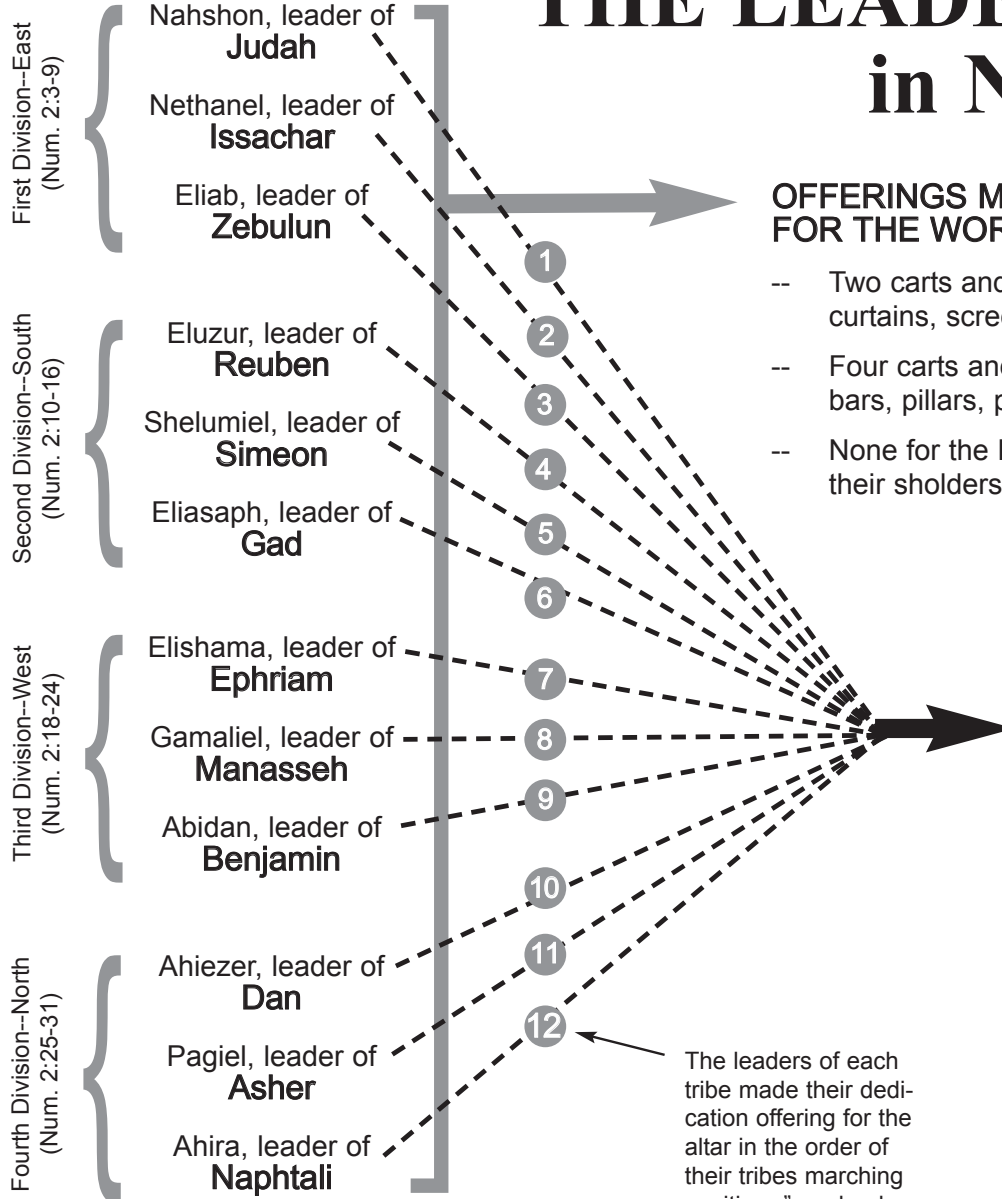


# THE LEADERS' OFFERINGS in Numbers 7



## OFFERINGS MADE FOR THE SERVICE OF THE LEVITES FOR THE WORK OF THE TABERNACLE (vv. 2-9):

- Two carts and four oxen for the Gershonites who carried the curtains, screens and cords (see 4:21-28)
- Four carts and eight oxen for the Merarites who carried the boards, bars, pillars, pegs sockets, cords and furnishings (see 4:29-33).
- None for the Kohathites, who were to carry the holy things on their sholders (see 4:4-20).

## DEDICATION OFFERINGS MADE WHEN THE ALTAR WAS ANOINTED (vv. 10-88):

*The leader of each tribe offered the following:*

- One silver platter of 130 shekels full of fine flour;
- One silver bowl of 70 shekels full of fine flour;
- One gold pan of ten shekels full of incense;
- One young bull, one ram, and one male lamb of the first year for a burnt offering;
- One kid of the goats as a sin offering;
- Two oxen, five rams, five male goats, and five male lambs in their first year for a peace offering.

FOR TOTALS: see verses 84-88

The leaders of each tribe made their dedication offering for the altar in the order of their tribes marching position--"one leader each day" (vv. 10-11).
